

2018 South African Test Tour Cricket Grounds

Test One KINGSMEAD STADIUM

Kingsmead is a cricket ground in Durban, KwaZulu-Natal, South Africa. It operates under the sponsorship-based name of Sahara Stadium Kingsmead. When a Test series is played in South Africa, the ground usually hosts the Boxing Day Test.

The venue hosted the first home Test for the South African cricket team after readmission into international cricket and also hosted the Test against the English cricket team in 1939, which lasted from the third to the 13th of March and was called off over fears that the English would miss their ship home.

It has been renowned as a seamers wicket, and there is also a famous myth regarding how the tide affects batting conditions, as the ground is quite close to the beach. Many batting collapses in matches in the past have jokingly been blamed on changes in the tide.

Test Two **ST GEORGE'S PARK**

St George's Park Cricket Ground is the home of the Port Elizabeth Cricket Club, one of the oldest cricket clubs in South Africa, as well as the Eastern Province Club. The ground is notable for its brass band that plays during major matches, adding a unique flavor to its atmosphere.


The ground hosted its first Test match in March 1889 when England defeated South Africa by 8 wickets. This was South Africa's first Test match. As of 2005, there have been 21 Test matches played at the ground of which South Africa has won 8 and their opponents 9 with 4 draws.

The first ODI played at the ground was in December 1992 when South Africa beat India by 6 wickets. As of 2005, there have been 25 ODIs played at the ground including five in the Cricket World Cup in 2003.

Test Three **NEWLANDS CRICKET GROUND**

Newlands is regarded as one of the most beautiful cricket grounds in the world, being overlooked by Table Mountain and Devil's Peak.

The land, owned by a brewer's daughter, is partly wetland and heavily wooded, was rented to the Western Province Cricket Club in 1887 for £50, with a 25 year lease being signed in 1888.

The ground was levelled and officially opened with a two-day match between Mother Country and Colonial Born. There was no scoreboard, and a pond existed behind the location of the current scoreboard.

Before the arrival of the Australians in 1902, which included Victor Trumper, the pine trees around the pavilion were replaced by oak trees. This is the site of the current Oaks Enclosure, one of the most popular vantage points. A then record crowd of 10,000 arrived to see the Test.

Test Four WANDERERS STADIUM

This cricket ground has staged some of the most important matches in ODI and T20 history, and has witnessed a number of outstanding world records.

This stadium hosted one of the greatest ODI matches, played between South Africa and Australian, when South Africa chased down Aussies's world record score of 434.

On 18 January 2015, the Wanderers stadium saw South Africa's AB de Villiers smash the record for fastest ODI half-century, previously held by Sri Lankan maestro Sanath Jayasuriya, when he made 50 off 16 balls against the West Indies. Incredibly, in the same match, he broke Corey Anderson's fastest ODI century record by making 100 runs off 31 deliveries. He finished on 149, caught out on the boundary in the final over, scored off 44 balls with a strike rate of 338.63.

MADIKWE GAME RESERVE

Madikwe Game Reserve is South Africa's 5th largest game reserve and also one of its best kept secrets. This hiddengem is regarded as one of the best conservation areas in Africa and offers over 75,000 hectares of pure African wilderness. The park hosts a number of luxurious lodges, each boasting amazing vistas and wildlife right at your doorstep.

Madikwe Game Reserve is situated in the malaria free North West Province, bordering Botswana. In addition to the Big Five of lion, leopard, elephant, rhino & buffalo, this highly rated reserve is renowned for its wild dog reintroduction as well as the unusual gemsbok, tsessebe and springbok. The lions in Madikwe originate from Etosha in Namibia and are renowned for hunting very large prey such as giraffe and eland.

In 1991 the area was declared a reserve and 10,000 endangered mammals were relocated from other National Parks. The park is home to approximately 66 wild mammal species and over 300 bird species. You will find a range of flora and fauna in an area comprised of vast open grassland plains, woodlands, rocky outcrops and mountains. The area is bordered in the south by the spectacular Dwarsberg Mountains.

The park is roughly 4.5 hours drive from Johannesburg with its safari lodges mostly located around the eastern and western fringes. The reserve is one-of-a-kind and is known for its involvement in the local communities complete with nearby community lodges that are owned and run by the local people, creating a healthy economic environment.

Our most recent tour to Madikwe Game Reserve was during the South Africa v Australia ODI series in 2016, where our clients enjoyed the thrill of seeing all of the Big Five species up close & personal during their morning, sunset & night game drives. Madikwe is quite simply as good as it gets - get ready for a truly incredible African safari experience!



MADIKWE RIVER LODGE

The Madikwe River Lodge is beautifully situated on the banks of the Groot Marico River in the heart of Madikwe Game Reserve, offering guests a unique place to relax and

VICTORIA FALLS

Victoria Falls presents a spectacular sight of awe-inspiring beauty and grandeur on the Zambezi River, forming the border between Zambia and Zimbabwe. It was described by the Kololo tribe living in the area in the 1800s as Mosi-oa-Tunya – The Smoke that Thunders. Victoria Falls were first sighted by Dr David Livingstone some 150 years ago and this legendary waterfall is known as the greatest curtain of falling water in the world.

Columns of spray can be seen from miles away as, at the height of the rainy season, more than five hundred million cubic metres of water per minute plummet over the edge, over a width of nearly two kilometres, into a gorge over one hundred metres below.

The wide, basalt cliff over which the falls thunder, transforms the Zambezi from a placid river into a ferocious torrent cutting through a series of dramatic gorges.

Facing the falls is another sheer wall of basalt, rising to the same height, and capped by mist-soaked rain forest. A path along the edge of the forest provides the visitor prepared to brave the tremendous spray, with an unparalleled series of views of the falls.

Victoria Falls is a World Heritage listed site where 1,000s of tourists flock each year to see the falls and thrill seekers swim in the Devil's Pool. Thanks to an underwater lip, the pool is on the border of the falls or the Zambia side and accessible during the dry season from August to January.

One special vantage point is across the Knife-edge Bridge, where visitors can have the finest view of the Eastern Cataract and the Main Falls as well as the Boiling Pot, where the river turns and heads down the Batoka Gorge. Other vantage points include the Falls Bridge, Devils Pool and the Lookout Tree, both of which command panoramic views across the Main Falls.

DAVID LIVINGSTONE LODGE

Built overlooking the mighty Zambezi river, the five star David Livingstone Safari Lodge and Spa offers sumptuous colonialstyled rooms and is a short drive away from Victoria Falls.

Each of the rooms is luxuriously decorated with four-poster beds draped in mosquito nets. All rooms have a private bathroom and the suites contain a hot tub and lounge area and you can enjoy the sunset from your own private balcony. The lodge has a spa and health club and a private river-cruise boat where you can experience spectacular sunset cruise on the Zambezi or enjoy a host of alternate activities from Elephant rides to Lion walks.



SUN CITY

One of Africa's premier vacation destinations, Sun City in South Africa is internationally recognised for its superb resort offering of hotels, attractions and world class events. From the lavish opulence of The Palace of the Lost City to the casual elegance of the Cascades, the glamour of the annual Nedbank Golf Challenge to the tropical thrills of the Valley of Waves, Sun City delivers plenty to see and do in a beautiful malaria free landscape.

Sun City was officially opened on 7 December 1979; at the time it was located in the Bantustan of Bophuthatswana. As Bophuthatswana had been declared an independent state by South Africa's apartheid government (although unrecognised as such by any other country), it could provide entertainment such as gambling and topless revue shows which were banned in South Africa.

Sun City also has two international-standard 18 hole golf courses, the Gary Player Country Club and the Lost City Golf Course, both designed by Gary Player. Tee times can be prebooked including club rental.

CASCADES HOTEL

Named for the waterfalls and calming pools that trickle throughout the property, the 5-star Cascades Hotel is an oasis of calm in the midst of the Sun City Resort, yet is in close proximity to all the activities Sun City has to offer. All rooms overlook the gardens and the white sands of the pool's beach area.

Free WiFi is available.

The Cascades restaurants include The Peninsula, a fine dining restaurant serving breakfast, lunch and dinner. The Bocado offers Mediterranean and vegetarian dishes, and guests can enjoy cocktails at Luma Bar.

THU 8 MAR: PORT ELIZABETH

Welcome to Port Elizabeth and South Africa. This beachside city with its colonial influences evident has plenty to offer its visitors. The 5km Donkin Heritage Trail will give you a great insight into the history of this area where over 40 national monuments and historical sites are linked.

For the wildlife lovers, there is the Addo Elephant Park, the 3rd largest National Park in South Africa and home to over 550 elephants, or the Kragga Kamma Game Reserve with plenty of free roaming animals to spot.

You might be interested in a Local Township Tour or happier to relax on one of the Blue Flag status beaches. Blue Flag beaches are accredited to beaches that have met high international standards of safety, cleanliness and facilities.

FRI-9 - TUE 13 MAR: 2ND TEST, SOUTH AFRICA V AUSTRALIA AT ST GEORGES PARK, PORT ELIZABETH

This Test will be a pivotal point in the series as Australia attempt to put in a much better performance here than on their last visit in 2014. In that match the hosts won the toss and chose to bat first making 423 with centuries to AB de Villiers and JP Duminy. Only Nathan Lyon (5-130) had

any real success with the ball. In reply the Aussies could only muster 246 with David Warner top scoring on 70 and found themselves with a daunting task when South Africa declared 447 runs ahead after their 2nd innings. Reaching 0-126 in their run chase, the Aussies must have felt they had a chance of causing a huge upset win, but 10 wickets for 90 runs later and only the openers making double figures, we were bundled out losing the Test by 231 runs.

During this Test Match you will be a guest at our Test Match dinner hosted by Merv Hughes which includes dinner, drinks and a special guest speaker.




This morning we take the flight to Victoria Falls via Johannesburg for the start of a fantastic week of touring.

THU 15 MAR: VICTORIA FALLS

Today will be an opportunity to get up close to these magnificent Falls as we take a short sightseeing Tour of the area. Victoria Falls is one of the world's great spectacles. The views of the Falls from the Zambian side are breathtaking whether seen from Knife Edge Point or from within First Gorge at the base of the falls. It attracts people who are there to witness the sheer power and beauty of the falls, or those who are after a serious adrenaline hit with the numerous extreme sports on offer.

This afternoon you can head back to our world class lodge and relax or you can participate in some of the optional activities available to purchase from the travel centre including fishing or game viewing in the Mosi-oa-Tunya National Park; adrenaline seekers can go abseiling, jet boating, white water rafting or bungee jumping.

FRI 16 MAR: FREE DAY

Today's free day gives you a wonderful opportunity to further explore the Falls, relax poolside at the lodge or take on a new activity. Chobe National Park and Hwange National Park are close enough to experience a full day tour. Chobe in Botswana has an abundance of wildlife and is also home to the largest concentration of elephants in Africa. Hwange is the oldest National Park in Zimbabwe and home to over 100 species of mammals and 400 bird species.

This evening, a buffet dinner is included at the lodge to celebrate our

last night at Victoria Falls.

SAT 17 MAR: SUN CITY

We depart Victoria Falls today and fly to Johannesburg. Upon arrival into the nation's capital, we board our coach bound for Africa's version of Las Vegas - Sun City.

It is the entertainment mecca of South Africa and although originally designed around gambling, this destination has taken on a more rounded experience for travellers of all ages. For the golf enthusiast there is the Gary Player Golf Course (home to the Nedbank Challenge) or the Lost City Golf Course and there are plenty of water activities including Waterworld and the Valley of the Waves. It also features live concerts and theatre, nightclubs, shopping, movies, restaurants and bars – there truly is something for everyone!

Overnight: Cascades Hotel or similar

SUN 18 MAR: FREE DAY

Today is a free day to explore the surroundings of this entertainment oasis or why not take in an early morning balloon ride or take the short 15km drive for a game drive at Pilanesberg National Park. The park is the 4th largest in South Africa and home to the Big 5 (lion, elephant, buffalo, leopard and rhino) and various other animals/birds including wild dog, hyenas and cheetahs.

MON-19 MAR: MAD!KWE GAME RESERVE, DUSK GAME DR!VE + BUSH D!NNER

This morning we do the easy coach drive from Sun City to Madikwe Game Reserve where we will have a wonderful two day game experience. Located close to the Botswana border, this is the 5th largest game reserve in South Africa and importantly is malaria-free. To make Madikwe the sanctuary it is today, more than 8000 animals were relocated here in one of the largest relocations of wildlife on earth by humans over a 7 year period.

After settling into our luxury lodgings, we will embark on our first game drive within this private game reserve on dusk. The reserve boasts the Big 5 game along with the African Wild Dog and Cheetah which now form the Super 7. We will have a great time ticking every animal off the list before settling in to a bush dinner under the stars regaling in stories from our earlier drive.

Overnight: Madikwe River Lodge or similar

TUE 20 MAR: GAME DRIVE + BOMA DINNER

It will be an early morning start today as we try to beat the animals out of bed on our dawn game drive. The local rangers and guides will take us around in their open top Landrovers searching out all of the famous animals including giraffe, warthog, kudu, hippo, crocodile, springbok, zebra and wildebeest to name just a few.

Breaking for lunch, we head back on the trail for an afternoon game drive and finish with a traditional Bush Boma dinner with all the

trimmings in what will be a tremendous way to finish our time here in Madikwe.

WED 21 MAR: CAPE TOWN-

It's a travel day today as we depart Madikwe and make our way to Cape Town via Johannesburg. Cape Town is by far the most popular city in South Africa for international tourists. It is a stunning coastal city boasting beautiful suburbs including Camps Bay, Clifton, Sea Point and Green Point. For wildlife lovers you may wish to visit the Two Oceans Aquarium, the World of Birds, Monkey Jungle or the Kirstenbosch Botanical Gardens. Other sites include the Castle of Good Hope, St George's Cathedral and the District Museum.

Our accommodation in Cape Town is situated very close to the world famous V&A Waterfront which is a bustling hive of activity with numerous shops, bars and restaurants on offer and tonight will be a great chance to sample some local delicacies ahead of tomorrow's 3rd Test Match.

THU 22 - MON-26 MAR: 3RD TEST, SOUTH AFRICA V AUSTRALIA AT NEWLANDS, CAPE TOWN

For the next 5 days we take our seats at one of the world's

A visa is required to enter South Africa. The visa needs to be applied for prior to travel and can be obtained either at the South African High Commission in

Wellington (NZ) https://www.sahc.org.au/consular_new-zealand.htm or **Canberra** (AUS) http://www.sahc.org.au/.

The visa is ZAR425 and requires supporting documents such as a valid passport, application form, return flight e-ticket and an itinerary. If this applies to you, please contact one of our sales staff who will be happy to provide more information.
