Batting first we made a huge total of 7/527 declared, with Michael Clarke compiling a wonderful 187 not out. We then took a 160 run lead at the halfway point thanks to Peter Siddle's 4-63 and Mitchell Starc's 3-76 restricting





England to 368 runs. A quick run chase in our 2nd innings saw wickets tumble before we set a target of 330 for the home team to chase, but the weather was against everyone and England finished precariously positioned on 3-37 as we all thought what could have been.







Grounds in the UK are extremely small by our standards (all grounds have a capacity of less than 30,000), and there is a huge ticket demand for an Ashes Series.





Test One EDGBASTON

Edgbaston Cricket Ground, also known as the County Ground or Edgbaston Stadium, is home to Warwickshire County Cricket Club and considered to be one of England's leading cricket grounds.

Edgbaston was the first English ground outside Lord's to host a major international one day tournament final when it hosted the ICC Champions Trophy final in 2013. With permanent seating for approximately 25,000 spectators, it is the fourth-largest cricketing venue in the United Kingdom, after Lord's, Old Trafford and The Oval.

In 1994, Brian Lara scored 501 at the ground playing for Warwickshire against Durham, the highest score by a batsman in first class cricket.

In 2005 Ashes, Australia lost to England by a mere two runs in the second Ashes Test, the closest Ashes match ever.

Test Two LORD'S

Lord's Cricket Ground, commonly known simply as Lord's, is named after its founder, Thomas Lord, and is owned by Marylebone Cricket Club (MCC). It is the home of Middlesex County Cricket Club, the England and Wales Cricket Board (ECB) and the European Cricket Council (ECC). Lord's is widely referred to as the Home of Cricket and is home to the world's oldest sporting museum. The historic pavilion is primarily for members of MCC and the only cricketer to hit a ball over the pavilion was Albert Trott, off a Monty Noble delivery in 1899.

One of the most distinctive features of Lord's is the significant slope across the field. The north-west side is 2.5m higher than the south-east side. This slope causes appreciable deviation in the ball bouncing on the pitch, making it easier to move the ball in to right-handed batters when bowling from the Pavilion End, and easier to move it away when bowling from the Nursery End.

Test Three **HEADINGLEY**

Headingley Cricket Ground, usually shortened to Headingley and is also known as Emerald Headingley Cricket Ground.

At this ground in the 1930 Ashes Test, Donald Bradman scored an innings total of 304 runs. In the 1948 Ashes series, Australia scored 3/404 on the last day to beat England helped by Arthur Morris score of 182 and Bradman's 173 not out.

In the third Test Match of the 1975 Ashes series (a four-test series), early on Tuesday 19 August head groundsman George Cawthray discovered that campaigners calling for the release from prison of George Davis had dug holes in the pitch, and poured oil over one end of the wicket. This led to the match being abandoned and declared a draw, denying England the chance to win back the Ashes.

Test Four OLD TRAFFORD

Old Trafford is home of Manchester Cricket Club and Lancashire County Cricket Club. It is England's second oldest Test venue and hosted the first Ashes Test in July 1884. The pitch at Old Trafford has historically been the quickest in England.

On this ground in 1956, the first 10-wicket haul in a single innings was achieved by English bowler Jim Laker - a record which remains unbeaten in Test and first-class cricket. In the 1993 Ashes Test, Shane Warne bowled Mike Gatting with the Ball of the Century.

During WWII, Old Trafford was a transit camp for troops returning from Dunkirk. In December 1940, the ground was hit by bombs and destroyed several stands. Despite the damage cricket resumed promptly after the war. The 'Victory Test' between England and Australia in August 1945 saw 76.463 attend the match over three days.

Test Five THE OVAL

The Oval is home for the Surrey County Cricket Club. Traditionally, the final Test Match of the English season is played here. The famous gasholders outside the ground were built around 1853 and are an integral part of The Oval's landscape.

In 1868, 20,000 spectators gathered at The Oval for the first match of the Aboriginal cricket tour of England, the first tour of England by any foreign side. The first Test Match in England was played at The Oval in 1880 between England and Australia.

The Oval hosted its 100th Test, against South Africa, on 27 July 2017, becoming the fourth Test venue after Lord's, MCG and SCG to do so. Moeen Ali also became the first player to take a Test hat trick at The Oval, bowling out South Africa in the second innings to win the match.
